SMOKE-FREE POLICY:

The Adelaide Plains Equestrian Club (“APEC”) recognises that passive smoking is hazardous to health and that non-smokers should be protected from tobacco smoke. This policy applies to all members, committee members, officials, coaches, riders, spectators, and visitors to APEC. Non-compliance with this policy may result in APEC not being eligible for government grants.

1. Smoking is not permitted during APEC events.
2. Persons wishing to smoke must leave the grounds to do so.
3. Persons failing to comply with this policy may face disciplinary action as outlined in the APEC constitution.
4. Cigarettes will not be offered for sale at APEC events and must not be provided to persons under the age of 18 years.

REVIEW / CONSULTATION

The review of this policy is the responsibility of the Adelaide Plains Equestrian Club Committee. This policy will be reviewed at least every three years.
